

What to Expect When You Visit

We respect the value of your time and make every effort to minimize unnecessary waiting. Colorado Urology Center is a surgical specialty however, and on occasion our physicians' help is needed immediately in the operating room. When we know far enough in advance that a delay may occur we will try to reach you by phone, so please be sure we have your daytime telephone number and your cell phone number.

If you are traveling a long distance to our office, please call us before leaving home. This way you can be sure that we have not had to schedule an emergency surgery that might delay your appointment.

When you come to the Colorado Urology Center, it is very likely that your doctor will want to test your urine. Therefore, please try not to empty your bladder before arriving at our office.

When your physician is ready to see you, your nurse will come to the reception area for you. At this time you will probably be asked for a urine specimen, if you have not already provided one. After reviewing your medical history with you, your physician will thoroughly explain what is to happen next based on the reason for your visit. Please be sure that all your questions are answered. We don't want you to leave without knowing what you came to learn. Should you think of something else after you go home, please call and speak with the nurse.

If you and your physician agree to proceed with lab work or diagnostic testing, please remind us if your insurance is a Managed Care plan, as we may need authorization from your family physician to proceed with testing.
